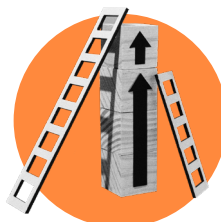

Present your study projects and discuss future anti-corruption challenges with an expert panel.

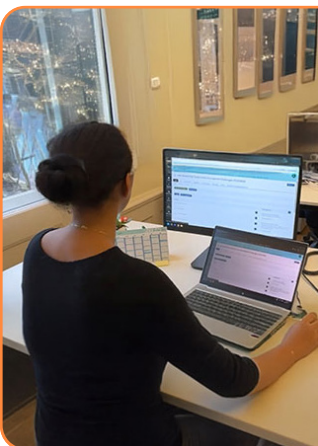
