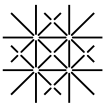

1. Purpose and scope (*Zweck und Geltungsbereich*)

This organisational plan, which is provided for in the Continuing Education Regulations (*Weiterbildungs-Ordnung der Universität Basel (WBO)*, § 15), contains the current details of the persons and institutions involved in the programme, as well as contact and internet addresses.

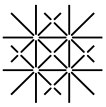

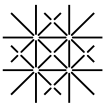
